

PAUL HARRIS FELLOWSHIP

Established in 1957, the **Paul Harris Fellowship (PHF)** honors Rotary founder Paul Harris and expresses appreciation and recognition for contributions to the Rotary Foundation. A Paul Harris Fellow is an individual who contributes \$1,000 or has that amount contributed in his or her name. The Paul Harris Sustaining Member, created in 1968, enables more people to participate by donating a minimum of \$100 with the stated intention of becoming a Paul Harris Fellow by accumulating a donation total of \$1,000. In November 1998, the Foundation's Trustees clarified the definition of Sustaining Members and renamed them Rotary Foundation Sustaining Members (RFSM). Beginning in 2004-05, Rotarians who give \$100 or more to the Annual Programs Fund will automatically become Rotary Foundation Sustaining Members.
