Service for Hudson Seniors

Presented by EMS Outreach of Hudson in conjunction with the City of Hudson's Fire, EMS and Police departments.





Do you live alone? Are you a Hudson resident? Are you a senior?

The **RU OK?** Program is a **FREE**

service that establishes a prearranged time for participants to receive a regular phone call inquiring about their welfare. During the call the participant will be asked "Are you OK?" If they answer "yes" they may hang up and continue with their day. If a concern is expressed, the volunteer caller will determine the nature of the concern and if some sort of response is necessary. Unanswered calls are called back. If there is still no response, the volunteer caller may request that an officer be dispatched to the location for a safety check.

WHAT IS THIS?

It's a **FREE** service for seniors who live alone or may not have someone to check on them.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

A trained volunteer will call you at a designated day and time to see if you are okay. If you don't answer, after a certain amount of time, a Hudson Police Officer will be sent to check on you.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Applications are available at the Hudson Library, churches, and some other locations within Hudson. You can also contact **Cindy Murphy** at Hudson EMS: **330-342-1852**. *Monday through Friday 8 am to 4 pm.*

NHV APPI V?

Applicants will receive a friendly and comforting call at least once a week at a time of their choice by a trusted volunteer. Additional calls can be made upon request.

Every wellness check gives peace of mind, not only to applicants, but to family members and friends. A designated emergency contact (a family member, friend, or neighbor) may also be contacted if the call goes unanswered for a short period of time.
